Policy for Children Attending a Performance

Our theatre provides a welcoming, comfortable, and safe environment for all patrons attending all performances. In this regard the admittance of children for performances is intended to result in an enjoyable experience for those bringing children to a performance, the children who attend, and all other patrons in attendance.

1. All persons, regardless of age, must have a ticket in order to attend a performance.
2. Children under the age of 5 are not permitted to attend productions unless the production is designated to be a “child friendly production” by the Board of Governors. Tickets for productions so designated may be purchased for children aged 3 and over. No one under the age of 3 is permitted to attend productions at the theatre.
3. Patrons may not hold children in their laps for an extended period of time during a performance. Booster seats are available upon request for all performances.
4. Strollers, carriers, walkers, or any such device for mobility assistance must NEVER obstruct public access or walking space in any way for more than the time required for the patron to be situated in place; it must then be removed from the auditorium.
