The Little Theatre of Alexandria (LTA) announces auditions for the Adult Cast of its 2026 production of Charles Dickens's *A Christmas Carol*. This year's show will be handled much differently from previous productions. First and foremost, the novella will be workshopped by the adult cast to explore new ways of dramatizing the story and to find fresh ways to quicken the now 183-year-old plot.

It is the hope that this process results in an ensemble production with each actor playing more than one role, except for the actor playing Scrooge. This production includes music of the era and seeks actors who can carry a tune and/or play an instrument such as guitar, violin, or piano; who can move and have a sense of rhythm; and who are eager to workshop and redramatize the story. Therefore, we are looking for the following primary roles:

Ebenezer Scrooge (50s)

Male Player 1: Narrator, who is Tiny Tim grown up.

LTA Policy

- ❖ Auditions are open to anyone wishing to try out. LTA is actively committed to conscious, diverse casting if race is not integral to the script.
- ❖ If cast, you must become a member of LTA. You may choose between a one-show performer's membership at \$20.00 or an annual/voting membership at \$50.00 per year.
- ❖ No one already cast in a current LTA production may be cast in this production without prior agreement from the Directors and Producers of both shows. All casting is tentative, and the Director shall have the right to exchange or substitute performers during rehearsals for such reasons as failure to appear, produce, learn lines, or be punctual.
- ❖ Performers will wear only the costumes, makeup, and wigs designed for them and approved by the Director and Producer.
- ❖ If cast, you agree to participate in any and all publicity photos/videos and agree these materials may be used by LTA for PR purposes without remuneration to you.
- ❖ Everyone over age 18 that is cast in this show will need to complete a background check.
